HOW TO RECYCLE IN ALTON

(Please Keep Schedule for Future Reference)

PLASTIC:

Acceptable – milk jugs, liquid soap bottles, antifreeze jugs (Type 1-5 plastics)
 Unacceptable – styrofoam

PAPER:

Acceptable – newsprint, letter quality paper, computer paper, magazines, advertising & books with glossy pages, colored typing paper

GLASS:

Unacceptable

CARDBOARD:

Acceptable – Corrugated Cardboard, Pizza Boxes (must be clean), Fiberboard (Cereal Boxes, soda boxes, etc.)

TIN CANS

And aluminum foil containers

ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS

1. Please clean and rinse all containers. Remove all labels from tin cans
2. Plastics may be flattened to save space.
3. Please DO NOT flatten tin cans.
4. Return all beverage cans and bottles to store for redemption.
5. Please have recyclables curbside by 7:00 a.m.
6. No garbage or medical waste allowed in container.
7. Container remains the property of OC Sanitation.
8. Extra recycling may be brought to OC Sanitation for disposal. Must stop in office.
